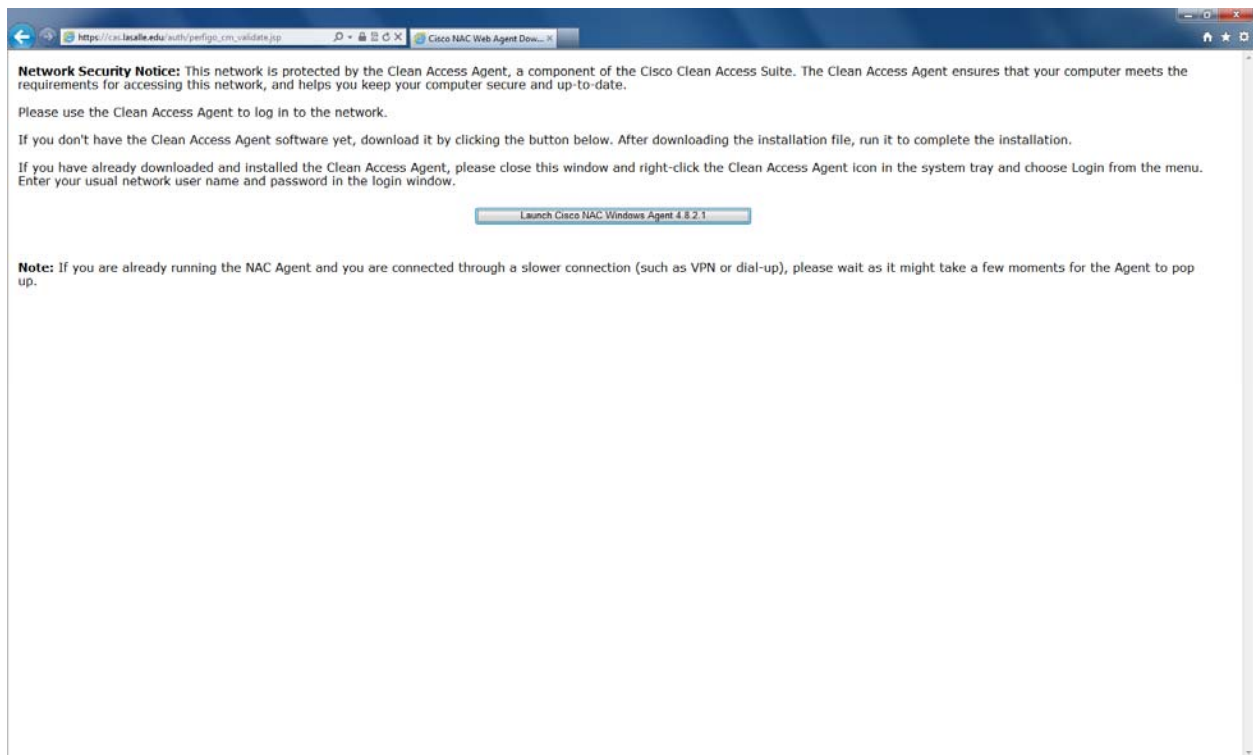

Enter your MyLasalle Portal username and password to login to the network.

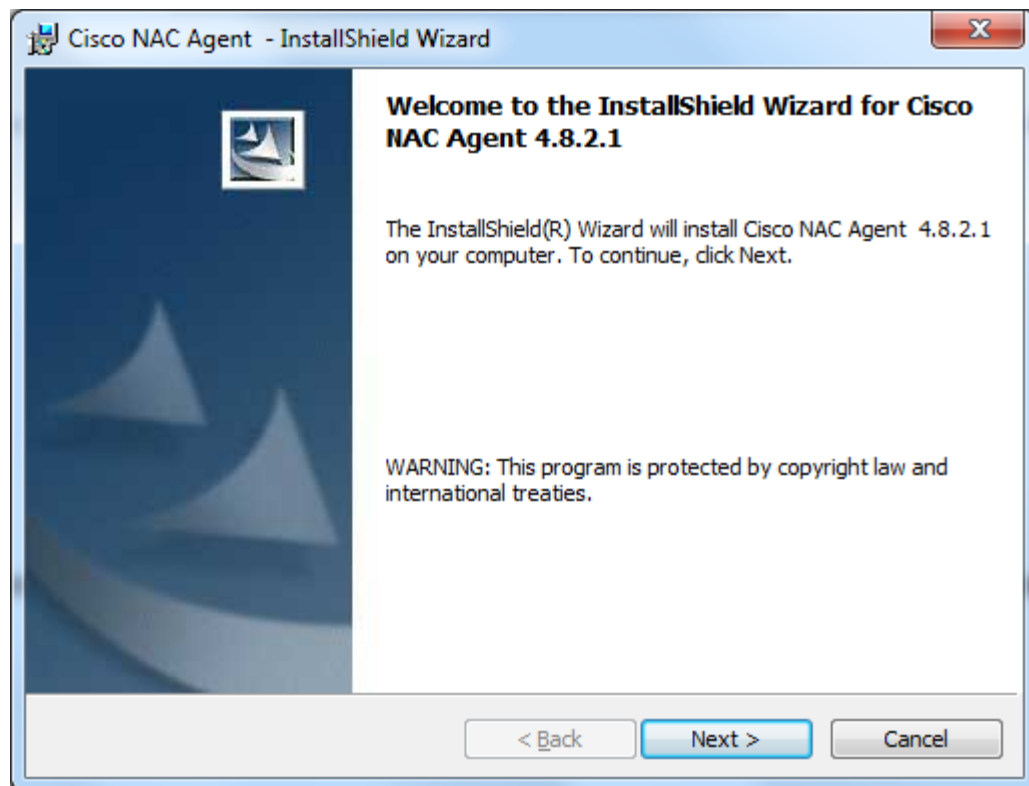

When you initially when connect to La Salle's network and attempt to access the internet, you will be brought to the page above. Here you will enter your myLasalle Portal credentials to begin the setup process.



After entering your credentials you will be brought to the download page.

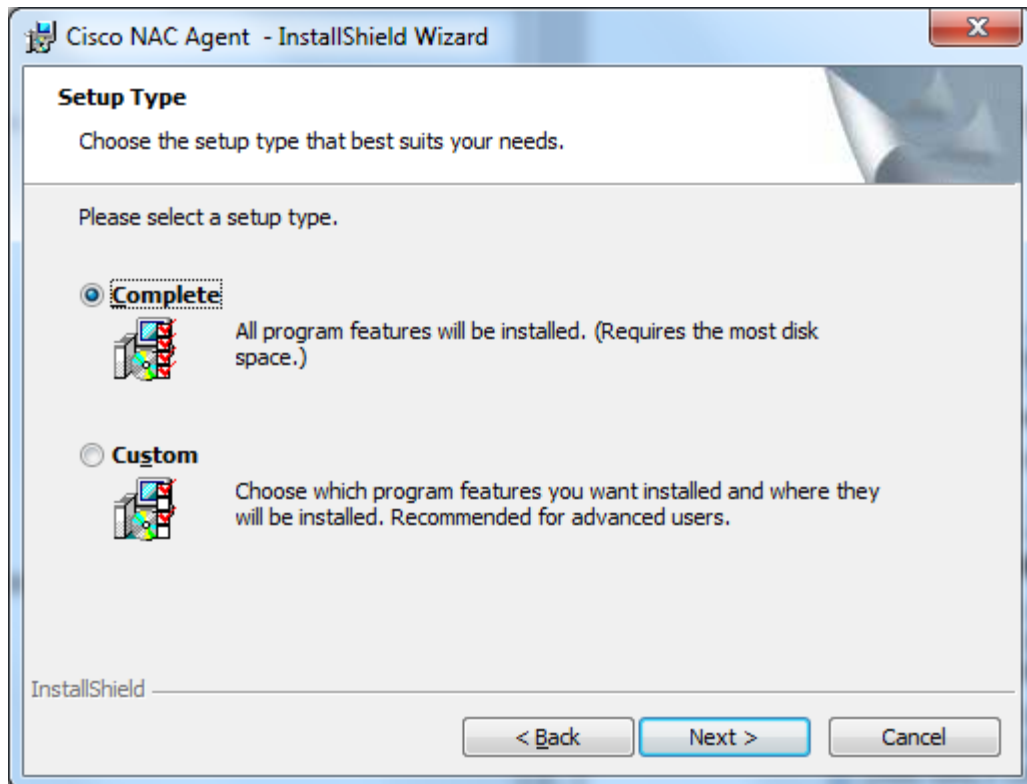
Click the “Launch Cisco NAC Windows Agent” button.



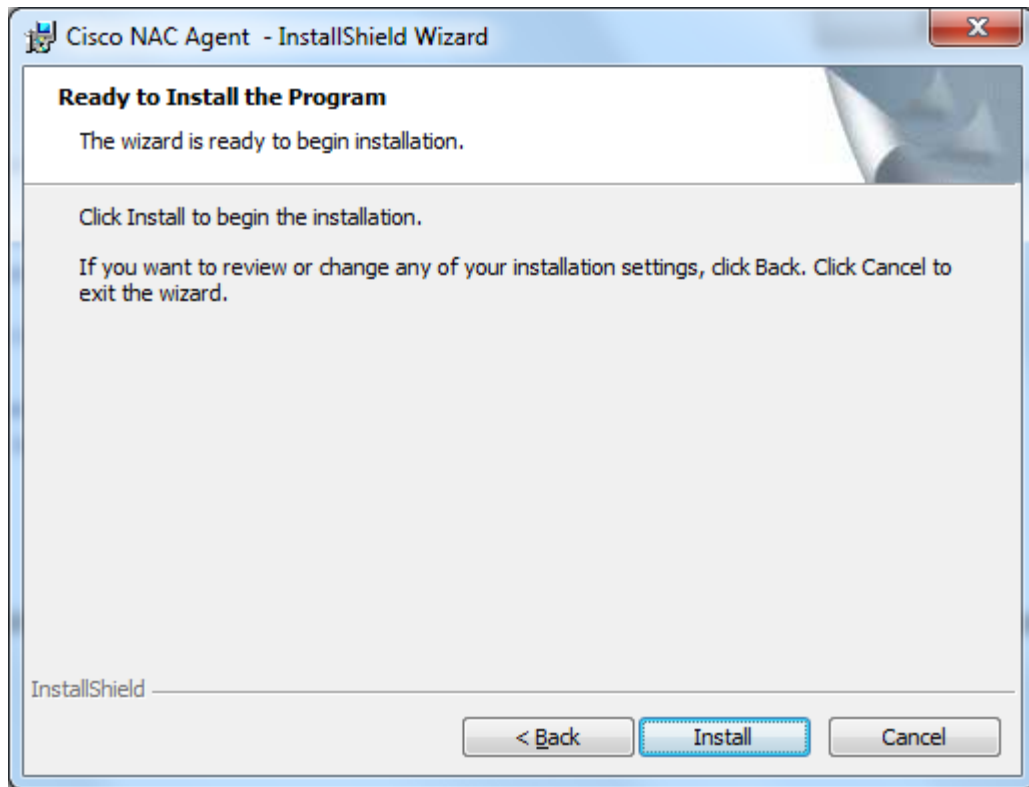
Click "Next".



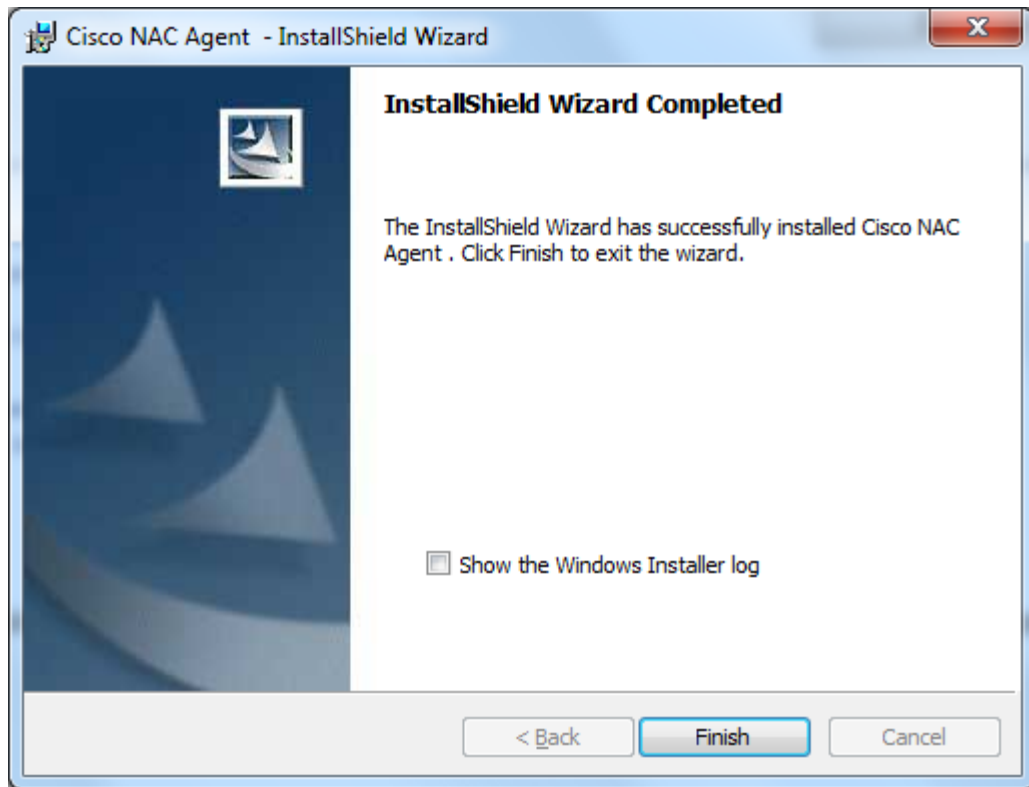
Click "Next" to accept the EULA.



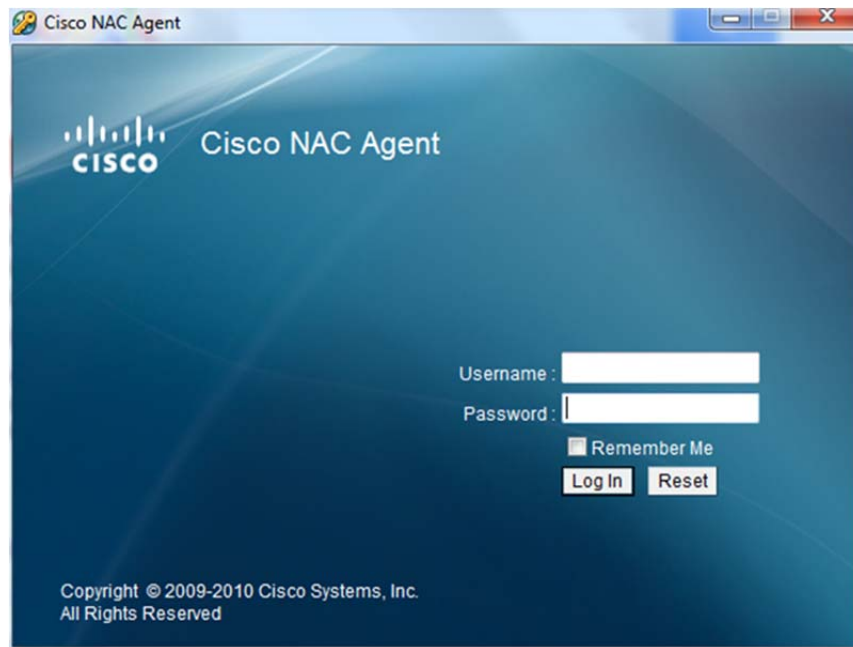
Select "Complete" then click "Next" to do a complete install.



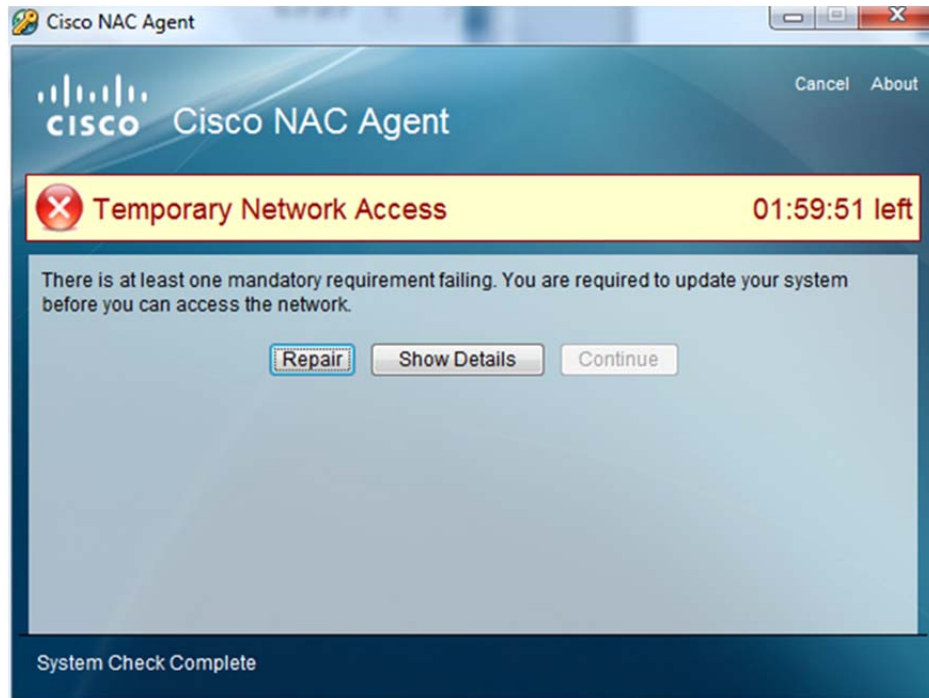
Click "Install" to start the installation.



Click “Finish” to complete the installation.



Once installed the Cisco NAC Agent login window will appear. Enter your myLaSalle Portal credentials.



If you have met all of the necessary requirements for our network Cisco NAC Agent will say “Full Network Access.”

Otherwise you will see this message and have to follow the instructions below.

There are five security settings Cisco NAC Agent checks for.

1. Microsoft Updates
2. McAfee FramePackage
3. McAfee VirusScan
4. McAfee Active
5. McAfee Update

If you are failing **Microsoft Updates** then you must go to Start > All Programs > Windows Updates and install any required updates.

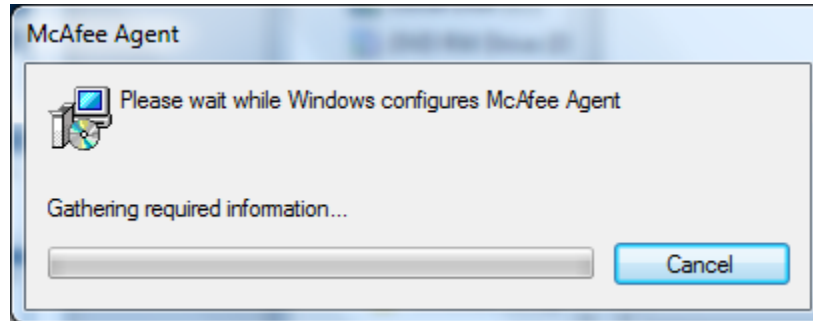
If you fail the **McAfee installation** requirements, follow the steps below.

Please note that before you install McAfee we recommend removing any other antivirus program due to conflicts that can occur.

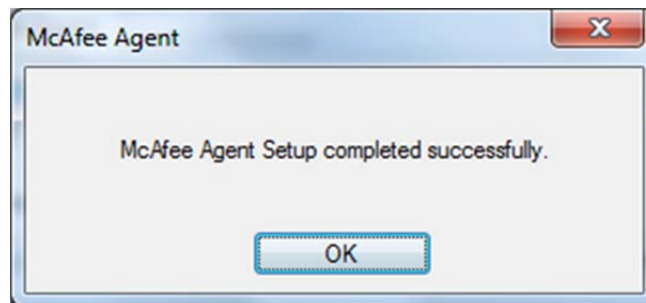
Click the repair button on Cisco NAC Agent to start the compliance process. It will prompt you to download any required software you are missing.

Locate the file downloaded. The default download location will be your Documents folder, although it may be located other places as well.

The first piece of software will be the FramePackage.
When you download and run the installer, this
window will appear.



When it finishes installing you will see this window.

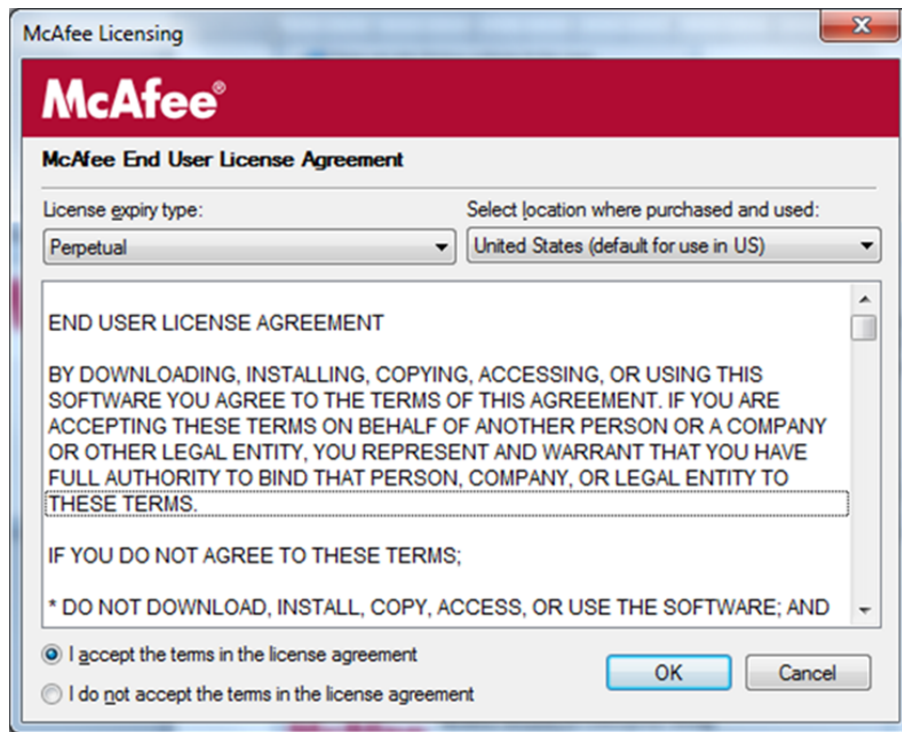


Click OK to close the dialog box.

Once the FramePackage is installed, the next step is to install McAfee Anti-Virus. Download the file from the Cisco NAC Agent. Unzip and open the “VSE88LML” folder. Locate the file called “SetupVSE.exe” Run this program to start the setup process.

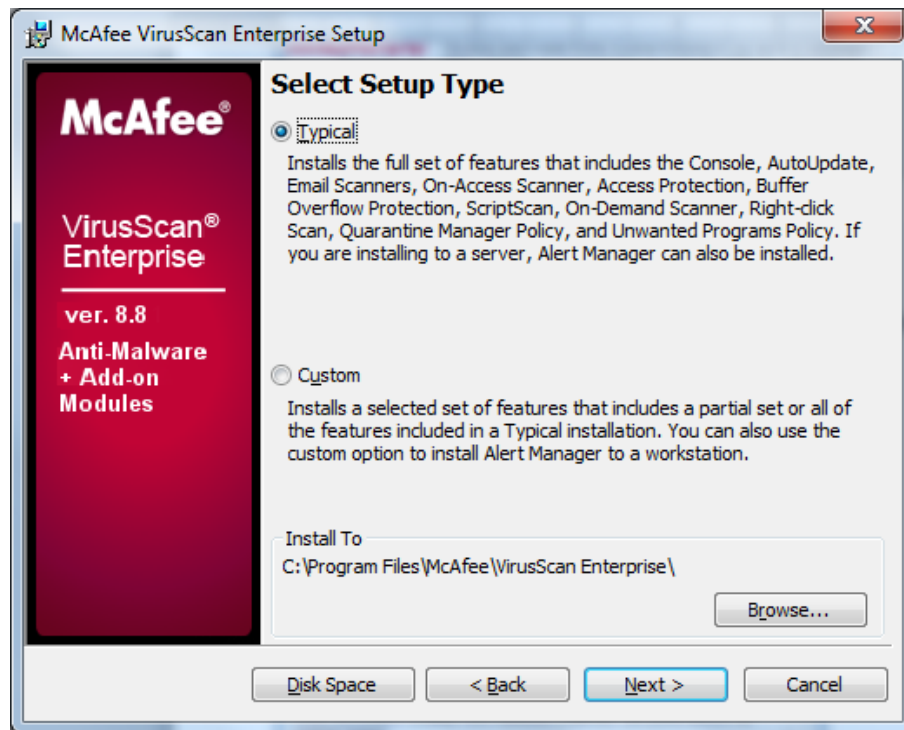


This window will appear. Click “Next” to begin the initial setup.



Under License expiry type, use the drop down menu to choose “Perpetual.”

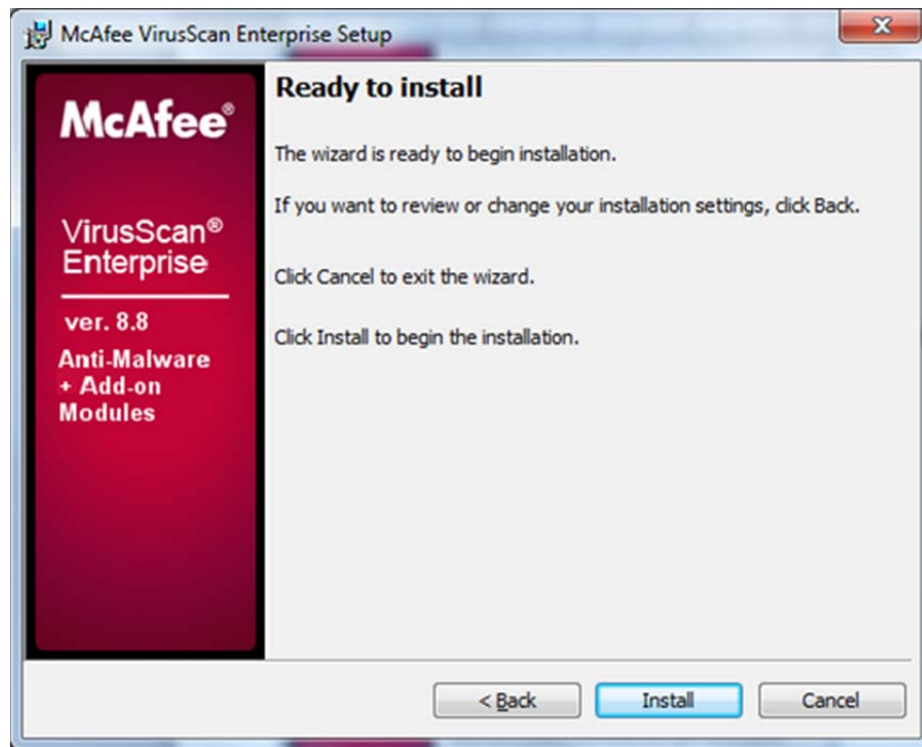
Then choose “I accept...” and click OK.



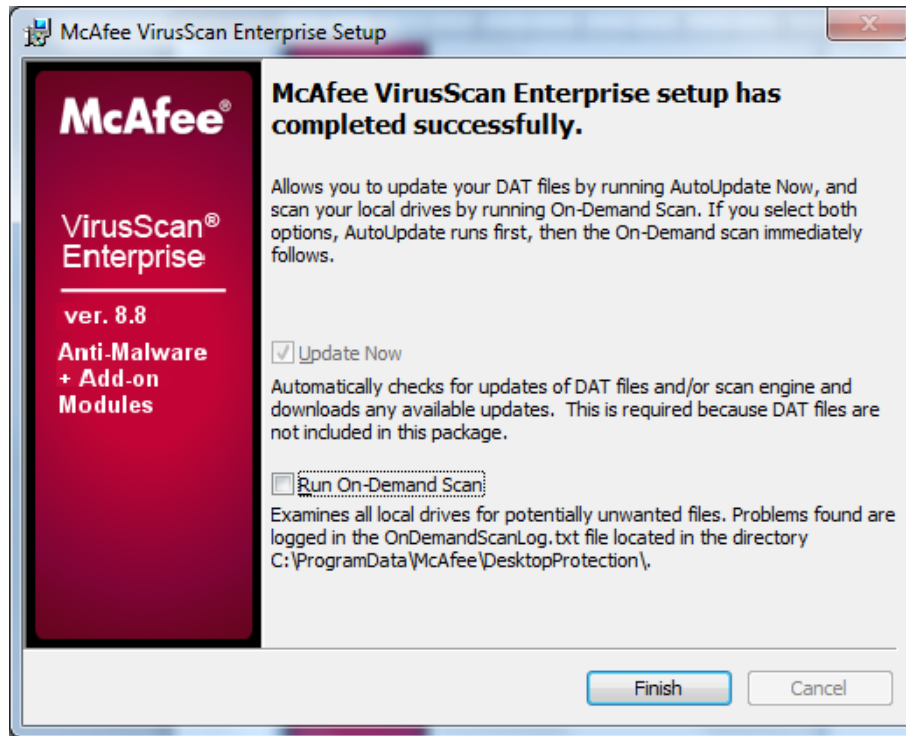
Choose “Typical” for the installation type and click “Next”.



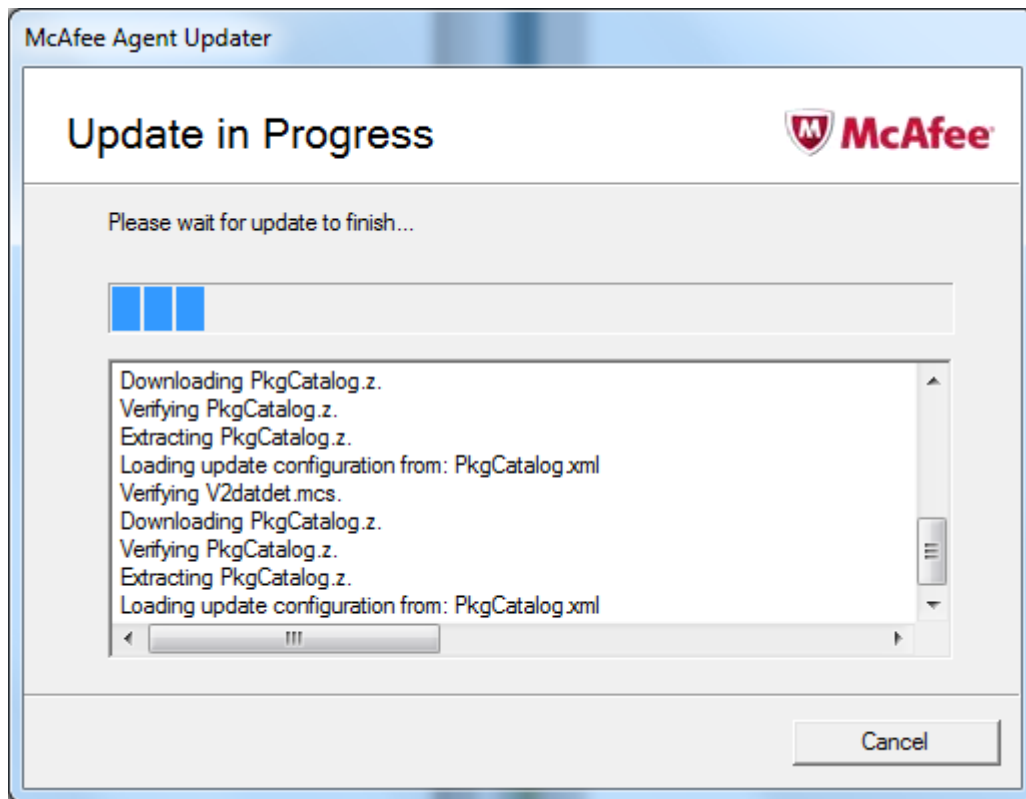
Choose “Standard Protection” and click next.



Click “Install” to start the McAfee install process.



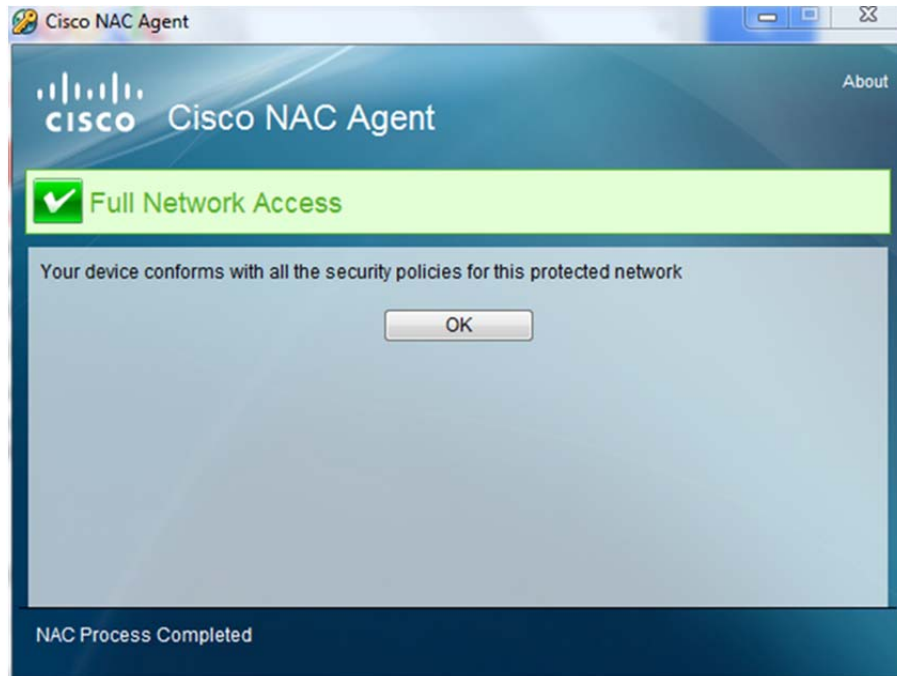
While it is recommend that you run an On-Demand scan once the setup completes, it can take an extended amount of time to do so. Click “Finish” once you have made your decision.



McAfee will now start updating.

(When the updating process completes the window will close automatically after 30 seconds.)

Once this is complete, sign out of and then back into the Cisco NAC Agent to check for final compliance.



Once all steps above are complete, the Cisco NAC Agent will give you full network access to La Salle's network.
